



## July 10<sup>th</sup> AQUATICS UPDATE

Dear Lemont Park District Community,

We are pleased to be able to expand our Aquatic Offerings once again during these unprecedented times. As stated in our last update and with the COVID-19 situation constantly ongoing, we will continue to provide various operational updates to the community! Here are some exciting updates for Aquatics:

- **NEW Lap Swim Options** – In addition to scheduled Lap Swim at the Centennial Outdoor Aquatic Center, Lap Swim will be available at The CORE during evening hours beginning Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>. Lap Swim is being offered to CORE Members and Lemont Residents for a daily fee and for one hour at a time. **Lap Swim will be available on a first come, first serve basis and swimmers will no longer need to reserve a lane ahead of time!** Spaces are limited with one swimmer permitted per lane and temperature checks will continue to be required. Two family members and/or friends may share a lane if they choose (but no more than two per lane).
- **“Day at the Pool”** – A “Day at the Pool” is a fun, special event at the pool in which Lemont Residents and their guests can enjoy time at the outdoor pool. This event is by **registration only** and is being offered on various days this summer. The slide, diving board, concessions and deck chairs, are not available at this time. If the pool is closed before 7 p.m. Monday, Wednesday, Friday or 3 p.m. Saturday and Sunday on the day of the event due to inclement weather, all participants will receive a household credit for the event fee.
