Dear Lemont Park District Community,

We hope this email finds you well and healthy. It has been brought to the attention of the Lemont Park District that two part-time employees and one contractor have recently tested positive for COVID-19. The contractor last worked on Friday, October 9th, and the two part-time employees last worked on Saturday, Oct. 10th; all were asymptomatic during their shifts. All three individuals also wore face coverings the entire time they were in The CORE and on Centennial Campus. Any specific members, guests or participants that we believe were in close contact with these people as defined by the CDC, have been notified.

Since the reopening of The CORE on July 1st, the District has implemented all state and federal safety guidelines to ensure the safest environment possible for staff, members and guests. Social distancing and wearing face coverings have been required to enter the facility and in all common areas and the cleaning and disinfecting measures have been implemented on a routine basis. Also, additional deep cleaning and closures have been implemented when and where necessary.

As the State of Illinois currently remains in Phase 4 – Revitalization – of the “Restore Illinois” plan, further guidelines are being made available as we continue to navigate these unprecedented times. The Lemont Park District will continue to closely monitor the ongoing COVID-19 situation and expand offerings where possible when state and federal guidelines permit.
