Dear Lemont Park District Community,

Today, the Governor announced that all regions that satisfy COVID-19 metrics will move to Tier 2 Mitigations. At this time, our community's region does not meet the necessary metrics. We are hopeful that this will change in the upcoming week(s). However, at this time, we continue to remain under [Tier 3, Phase 4 Resurgence Mitigations](#). Once our region (Region 10) satisfies the specific necessary COVID-19 metric criteria, we will move into Tier 2. Staff is working diligently on preparing to expand programs and operations where we are able to once we are in Tier 2 Resurgence Mitigations. Here are some current operational reminders as the District remains in Tier 3:

- **All group In-person Indoor Programming and Sports are temporarily suspended. Programs due to begin the week of January 18<sup>th</sup>, will be POSTPONED and not cancelled. Current program information will be forthcoming as soon as it's made available.**
- **Outdoor Programming and Sports are allowed.** Groups must practice social distancing and are limited to 10 people or less. Face coverings are required at all times for all activities.
- **The CORE Fitness & Aquatic Complex** – The Fitness Center is open for MEMBERS ONLY and is limited to 25% capacity. Individual Lap Swim is also available for CORE Members at the indoor pool. **Members must make a reservation for the fitness center or lap swim prior to visiting The CORE.** The CORE is currently accepting new members. At this time, indoor Group Fitness and Aquatic classes are not permitted under Tier 3 Mitigations. - **Centennial Community Center** will remain closed and will reopen upon returning to Phase 4 Restore Illinois operations.
