Dear Lemont Park District Community,

As of Saturday, January 23, 2021, Region 10 (Lemont's Region) entered into Tier 1, Phase 4 Resurgence Mitigations as outlined by the Governor and the Illinois Department of Public Health. Here is a summary of how this tier of mitigations will highly affect District Operations **BEGINNING ON Wednesday, Jan. 27th**:

- **In-person, Indoor Programming and Sports** – are permitted to resume and are limited to 50% of room capacity or 50 people, whichever is less. ***Social Distancing and masks are required.*** Participants on program waiting lists that we are now able to accommodate, will be contacted.
- **Special Events remain at 25 people maximum** – Under the current Resurgence Mitigation guidelines set forth by the state for the region in which the Lemont Park District operates (Region 10), meetings, gatherings and special events are limited to either 25 people or less (or 25% capacity).
- **The CORE Fitness & Aquatic Complex** – The Fitness Center is open for MEMBERS ONLY and is now limited to 50% capacity. Individual Lap Swim is also available for CORE Members at the indoor pool. ***Members are no longer required to make a reservation for the fitness center but must still do so for lap swim prior to visiting The CORE.*** The CORE is currently accepting new members. **Indoor Group Fitness and Aquatic Classes are now permitted to operate at 50% room capacity. Social Distancing and masks are required.** Classes will be for CORE-Fit Members only and reservations and face coverings are required. Here are a few operational reminders in place:

- **Centennial Community Center** has reopened and the hours of operations are as follows: Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Closed Saturday and Sunday. ***Hours are subject to change.***
- **FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED** in all District facilities and during all programming, including in the fitness center and during fitness classes, except while in the indoor pool.

We will continue to closely monitor the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic situation and expand offerings where possible when state and federal guidelines permit. We thank you for your continued support and patience as we do our best at serving you!
