Dear Lemont Park District Community,

Happy New Year! We hope you enjoyed the holiday season. At the District, we are very excited to embark on a new year and continue to serve our community. As we all navigate through the COVID-19 pandemic, the State of Illinois safety mandates and guidelines continue to change. Per Governor Pritzker, on Friday, November 20th, the State of Illinois entered into [Tier 3, Phase 4 Resurgence Mitigations](#). On Wednesday, January 6th, the Governor announced that all regions will continue to remain under the Tier 3 Mitigations until at least Friday, January 15th (a week from this Friday), as his office and the IDPH continue to monitor the impact of holiday activities on the state's COVID-19 Region Metrics. The Governor also announced that beginning January 15th, any region that satisfies the metrics for doing so may move to Tier 2.

As the state remains in Tier 3 resurgence mitigations, here are some reminders as to how this will continue to affect Lemont Park District operations at least until the 15th of January:

- **All group In-person Indoor Programming and Sports are temporarily suspended.** The Lemont Park District team continues to work at adapting any and all programming to virtual models OR offer one-on-one private options. As soon as possible, the District will begin to expand offerings. With this very fluid situation, most refunds and household credits may be processed when Phase 4 operations are able to resume.
- **Outdoor Programming and Sports are allowed.** Groups must practice social distancing and are limited to 10 people or less. Face coverings are required at all times for all activities.
- **The CORE Fitness & Aquatic Complex** – The Fitness Center is open for MEMBERS ONLY and is limited to 25% capacity. Individual Lap Swim is also available for CORE Members at the indoor pool. **Members must make a reservation for the fitness center or lap swim prior to visiting The CORE.** The CORE is currently accepting new members. At this time, indoor Group Fitness and Aquatic classes are not permitted under Tier 3 Mitigations. - **Centennial Community Center** will remain closed and will reopen upon returning to Phase 4 Restore Illinois operations.

As always, the Lemont Park District will continue to closely monitor the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic situation and expand offerings where possible when state and federal guidelines permit. It is our hope that we will be able to do this on or after January 15th. We thank you for your continued support and patience as we do our best at serving you! Wishing you all a very happy and healthy 2021.
