Kindergarten Enrichment Payment Options

At time of registration, you are required to make a \$100.00 **NON- Refundable** deposit. This deposit will be deducted from your child's Kindergarten Enrichment program costs. The remaining balance will be divided in 9 installments. Installment will be due on August 10th, September 10th, October 10th, November 10, December 10th 2021, January 10, 2022, February 10, 2022, March 10th ,2022 and April 10, 2022.

You must choose one of the following payment options below for the remainder of your tuition. Paying your tuition in **FULL** is always an option and therefore does not require you to make a selection below.
