

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEMONT PARK DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, COOK, WILL AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

SECTION 1

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Lemont Park District for 2021 (payable in 2022) will be held on Wednesday, December 1st, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. at Lemont Park District Centennial Building at 16028 W. 127th, Lemont, IL 60439.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2020 (payable in 2021) were \$2,806,033.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2021 (payable in 2022) are \$2,964,936. This represents a 5.66% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2020 (payable in 2021) were \$2,088,926.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2021 (payable in 2022) are \$2,001,504. This represents a 4.19% decrease over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2020 (payable in 2021) were \$4,894,959.
- V. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2021 (payable in 2022) are \$4,966,440. This represents a 1.46% increase over the previous year.
