Perhaps nothing means that I played with blocks, or counted to ten, or sorted some rocks.

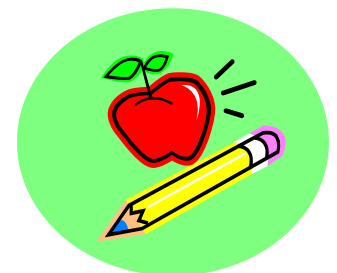
Maybe I watched the fish eat today, or went outside to the park to play.
