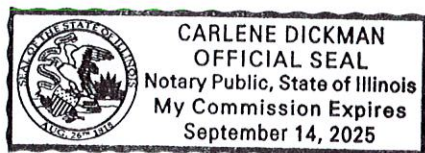



ORDINANCE NO. 2022-6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION
OF TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2022 OF THE LEMONT PARK DISTRICT
IN COOK, WILL AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEMONT PARK DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,
COOK, WILL AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

SECTION 1

That a tax in the sum of three million and one hundred fifty five thousand and six hundred fifty one dollars (\$3,155,651) or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, to defray all expenses and liabilities for the antic objects and purposes specified below, and the same hereby is, levied on all taxable property within the Lemont Park District subject to taxation in the current tax year, at full, fair cash value as the same is assessed and equalized for State and county purposes in the amounts so required or hereafter itemized as follows:

SECTION 3

That the County Clerks of Cook, DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois, be and are hereby authorized and instructed to levy a separate tax in addition to the amount authorized to be levied for all corporate purposes, for each and every item in Section 1 of this Ordinance that is a Special Tax Levy in accordance with those certain sections of the ILLINOIS PARK DISTRICT CODE and other applicable statutes authorizing such additional ta

SECTION 4

That the Secretary of the Board of Park Commissioners be and hereby is directed to file with the County Clerks of Cook, DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois, in due time and in the manner prescribed by law, a copy o Ordinance cerified by said Secretary as to its enactment, accompanied by a certificate of the presiding officer as to compliance with the Truth in Taxation Law, and said County Clerks are hereby directed to extend taxes sufficient to produce the amounts levied herein in accordance with applicable law.


SECTION 5

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.





**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY
TAX INCREASE FOR LEMONT PARK
DISTRICT, COOK, DUPAGE AND
WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.**

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Lemont Park District for 2022 (payable in 2023) will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at Lemont Park District Safety Village at 55 Stephen Street, Lemont, IL 60439.

Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may contact Louise Z. Egofski, Executive Director, Lemont Park District 16028 W. 127th St., Lemont, IL 60439, 630-257-6787.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2021 (payable in 2022) were \$2,873,065.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2022 (payable in 2023) are \$3,155,651. This represents a 9.84% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2021 (payable in 2022) were \$2,099,529.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2022 (payable in 2023) are \$2,044,799. This represents a 2.61% decrease over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2021 (payable in 2022) were \$4,972,594

- V. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2022 (payable in 2023) are \$5,200,450. This represents a 4.58% increase over the previous year.
