AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2023 OF THE LEMONT PARK DISTRICT IN COOK, WILL AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEMONT PARK DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, COOK, WILL AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

SECTION 1

SECTION 4

That the Secretary of the Board of Park Commissioners be and hereby is directed to file with the County Clerks of Cook, DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois, in due time and in the manner prescribed by law, a copy of Ordinance cerified by said Secretary as to its enactment, accompanied by a certificate of the presiding officer as to compliance with the Truth in Taxation Law, and said County Clerks are hereby directed to extend taxes sufficient to produce the amounts levied herein in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 5

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
